

**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS OF
DENTON COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 11-A**

Denton County Fresh Water Supply District No. 11-A, your retail water provider, previously has implemented its Drought Contingency Plan at the request of Upper Trinity Regional Water District (UTRWD), which supplies wholesale treated water to District 11-A.

Despite occasional rains, our area continues to experience an overall rainfall deficit that affects the availability of surface water to be treated for use by District 11-A. As a result, UTRWD has requested that its wholesale customers, including District 11-A, continue to implement water conservation measures.

Based on UTRWD's request, the following mandatory restrictions previously implemented are still in effect:

- **Landscaping may not be watered more than two times per week.**
- **Landscaping may be watered only before 10:00 a.m. or after 6:00 p.m.**

UTRWD has requested these continued restrictions in anticipation of another hot, dry summer.
